*For a very special reason...*

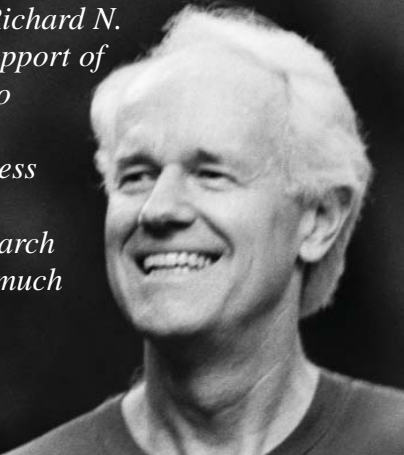
